RESOLUTION No. 2017-5

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING A PLAN OF STREET LIGHTING  
AND A PROPOSED SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, heretofore the Commissioners of TRAILS END WATER DISTRICT #2 (hereinafter referred to as the "District") have, from time to time, established policies and fixed charges pertaining to the supply of water to customers, the Commissioners have also discussed the establishment and provision of street lighting within the District as allowed by RCW 57.08.060, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined after discussion and consultation that it has now become economically viable to address street lighting within the District, it is now, therefore,

RESOLVED that

The Board shall propose to the District that street lighting be established. The Board proposes that the areas of service shall include all areas within the boundaries of the District, but that such service may be provided in some areas at a later date depending on the economic viability of using existing structural materials or having to provide the materials and labor to build such infrastructure.
